Cell Phones

Students at Bayside high School will adhere to the newly adopted Cell Phone Policy (Please see attached). Students who do not adhere to the Pinellas County Cell Phone will receive progressive discipline consequences.

Attendance

Attendance = Graduation - Please make sure your student is arriving at school and ready to participate in learning by 7:25 each day.

Food Services

- **Breakfast & Lunch**
 - Breakfast is served at 7:05 A.M. and lunch is served at 12:05 P.M. Both meals are free to Bayside High School students. It is my hope that we will have a fully operational cafeteria by September instead of food being delivered from another school.
 - Students who arrive on a late bus, will be able to have a grab and go breakfast item from the cafeteria.
- **Water Bottles**
 - We have refillable water stations. For safety purposes, please make sure your student has a plastic water bottle. No glass bottles are permitted.
- **Outside Food Delivery**
 - Outside food deliveries (UBER Eats, Door Dash, etc.) are not allowed at Bayside High School.
 - If students bring food to school, they will need to eat the food prior to attending class.

Back to School Forms

The district has consolidated all Back-to-School forms, so parents can fill them out in one place - online. Parents can log into Focus at focus.pcsb.org and complete their Back-to-School Forms packet. They will be prompted to fill out the forms as soon as they log onto Focus.
