



- English: If you haven't tried an advance course yet, Pre-AICE English Literature is a good place to start. It is the equivalent to English II Honors. AICE General Paper is another good course to try if you want to jump into a full advanced course. If you have already taken AICE General Paper, AICE English Language will further challenge you, and provide you with an opportunity to earn college credit for Comp I.
- Math: Students who are taking Algebra and feel confident about passing the class and the Algebra EOC should select Geometry or Pre-AICE Math 2. Pre-AICE Math 2 is the equivalent of Geometry Honors. If you would like to strengthen your math skills before moving on to Geometry, select Liberal Arts Math. Please note that some universities and the Bright Futures Scholarship may not recognize Liberal Arts Math.
- Science: Biology and Biology Honors are the two most selected sciences for sophomore students. If you took Biology (H) as a freshman, please select one of the other science courses listed above.
- Social Studies: All sophomores must take a world history course or its equivalent. World History Honors is a great place to start if you would like to challenge yourself a little bit. The other courses listed count as a world history credit and provide students with opportunities to earn college credit.
