As you prepare for your junior year, it is important to understand how significant this year will be. If you have not done so already, this is the year to challenge yourself, take advanced courses, and strengthen your GPA!

These instructions will walk you through completing the reverse side of this course request form. If you have any questions, please ask a school counselor. They are always excited to help students create a plan to meet their academic goals.

Step A: Select your pathway to graduation.

Refer to the DHHS Curriculum Guide for detailed information on the graduation pathways, and all courses offered at Dixie Hollins. The curriculum guide can be found on the Dixie Hollins High School website.

Step B: Select your core academic classes.

- **English:** If you haven't tried an advance course yet, AICE General Paper is a good place to start. It can count as any English credit. If you have already taken AICE General Paper and/or other AICE English courses, then dual enrollment Comp I is great option to challenge yourself further, and earn college credit.
- **Math:** Students completing Lib Arts Math will move on to Geometry. However, students taking Geometry or Pre-AICE Math 2 should seek their teachers input before selecting the next level of math. Pre-AICE Math 3 is the equivalent of Algebra 2 Honors.
- **Science:** There are a variety of science options for the 11th grade. We encourage students to attempt an AICE science course. Students selecting an advanced science course may want to consider requesting Experimental Science Honors as an elective to support the work being done in their advanced science course.
- **Social Studies:** All juniors must take a US History course or its equivalents.
