Students who are not taking Algebra in the 8th grade should, select regular Algebra 1 or Algebra 1 A/B block. Consult with your current math teacher about which Algebra course is best for you.
- **Science:** Students taking an advanced science in 8th grade should select Biology or Biology Honors. All other students should select one of the Earth Space Science options.
- **Social Studies:** All incoming freshmen need to select one of the three Freshmen Leadership courses. For AVID, please use the QR code to apply.
