BCHS Modified Dress Code Parameters:

Top

- Polo shirts, collared shirts, or crew neck t-shirts with writing, imaging, and logos, and embellishments are allowed, but must be free of the following: profanity; violent images, wording or suggestions; sexually suggestive phrases or images; gang related symbols; alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or advertisements for such products

Bottom

- Worn at the waist and extend below the knee
- No form fitting or spandex bottoms

General

- No rips, holes, or cuts in clothing
- Undergarments must not be visible
- Footwear can remain flexible – sandals, flip flops, open toe, slides, etc. but no slippers
- All other aspects of the PCSB dress code are still in effect
