
Tropicana Has Moved to Open Seating


- Guests will need a general admission ticket and seating will be first come, first served (similar to previous years). Use this link -> https://form.jotform.com/PCSB/boca-ciega
- Type in the name of a graduate (or a guest)
- Enter R2.D2 or "guest"
- Enter the remaining information
- Be sure to correctly enter the email address you would like the ticket (with bar code) emailed to – you will receive the email in minutes

Tropicana Field Parking

- Parents, guests, and students should park in lot #1, 6, or 7. There is a \$10 charge per car for parking credit/debit card only
- Lots 6 and 7 are reserved for rideshares (Uber, etc.)
- Parents and guests will enter through gate 1 or 5
- Graduates will enter through gate 1 (be there by 6:30am)
- Persons with disabilities can use gate 1 or 5
- Gates to enter the stadium open at 6:45am







Things for us to review:

- Dress for females white dress and white or beige colored shoes, no tennis shoes or flip flops
- Dress for males collared dress shirt (preferably white) with a necktie (dark tie) and dark shoes (no tennis shoes or flip flops)
- Do not decorate your cap and gown
- Leave all electronics with family or in your car
- Get rid of gum before you arrive
- All students will enter the stadium through a check in process, if you are not "ready" you will be turned away!

Things for us to review:

- Lining up process alphabetical by gender
- Your 3x5 card
- Cap tassel should be on your right side
- Cords and medallions
- Program agenda:
 - Processional
 - National Anthem
 - Vigue welcome, intro of guests
 - Salutatorian speech
 - Valedictorian speech
 - Vigue speech
 - Presentation of diplomas (lots of hand shakes and smiles)
 - Tassels (right to left)
 - Recessional (order for exiting)

Things you and your family should <u>not</u> do:

- Bring balloons, flowers, noise makers, signs or strollers to the stadium (none will be allowed)
- Wear high heels
- Steal someone else's moment in the sun by calling out, etc.
- Anything that would not make everyone proud

After the ceremony:

- Hallway tables to pick up diploma or obligation notice. If you receive an obligation notice, you'll need to return to school to see the bookkeeper the day after graduation
- You'll exit through lower gate 6, so be sure to proceed to parking lot 1, 6 or 7 to meet your family for picture, etc.
