

2020 Summer Learning Opportunities at Countryside High School

- What: Students who are performing below grade level in reading or math, those needing to recover credits in CORE classes they earned a D or F, and incoming freshmen wanting an early high school experience (Summer Bridge).
- When: See below for program specific for dates (Mon.-Thur. from 8:30-12:30)
- Where: Countryside High (unless otherwise noted). **Transportation is not provided!**

- I. **Algebra 1 Credit Recovery (Registration Forms in Guidance)**
 - a. This program is for current 9th-11th graders needing to retake Algebra 1 for grade forgiveness or to earn credit for a previously failed Algebra 1 class
 - b. **June 8th-July 2nd**
 - c. Earn an elective credit & apply a grade of 'C' or higher to forgive prior failed Algebra 1 course or to forgive a D/F grade
- II. **Algebra 1 EOC Retake Test Prep (Registration Forms in Guidance)**
 - a. **July 6th - 16th** (includes middle schoolers who failed the Algebra 1 EOC)
 - b. Test dates: **July 15th & 16th**
 - c. Earn an elective credit & apply a grade of 'C' or higher to forgive prior failed Algebra 1 course or to forgive a D/F grade
- III. **ACT ELA Prep (Registration Forms in the Guidance Office)**
 - a. Rising 11th graders needing to pass the 10th grade FSA (**July 6th- 16th**)
 - b. Rising & current 12th graders who need a concordant score for graduation (**July 8th-16th**)
 - c. ACT Test is July 18th
 - d. Voucher registration will be completed during ACT Prep class (No Date Yet)
- IV. **APEX Credit Recovery (including continuing G.E.P.)**
 - a. This program is for students who earned a D or F in a CORE academic class (both semesters offered)
 - i. Math: Algebra 2, Geometry, Math for CR, and Liberal Arts
 - ii. Social Studies: Government, US History, World History, Economics
 - iii. English: English 1 – 4
 - iv. Science: Biology, Earth Space, Environmental, Physical
 - b. **June 8th – July 18th**
 - c. **Countryside students, see your School Counselor to register**
- V. **College Experience/College Success (Registration Forms in the Guidance Office)**
 - a. Rising 12th graders who do not have an accelerated course completed
 - b. **July 8th-16th**
- VI. **Freshman Experience/Freshman Prep (Registration online through SRS)**
 - a. Class of 2024 (incoming 9th graders)
 - b. Session 1 (**June 8th-18th**) of Session 2 (**June 22nd-July 2nd**)
