- I. **Summer Credit Recovery (including continuing G.E.P.)-APEX**
 - a. This program is for students who are currently behind in a CORE academic class (both semesters offered)
 - i. Math: Algebra 2, Geometry, Math for CR, and Liberal Arts
 - ii. Social Studies: Government, US History, World History, Economics
 - iii. English: English 1 – 4
 - iv. Science: Biology, Chemistry, Earth Space, Environmental, Physical
 - b. **June 14th - July 15th from 8:00a -12:00p (Grades 9-11)**
 - c. **June 14th - July 29th from 8:00 – 12:00p (Grade 12 only)**
 - d. **Submit a signed APEX registration form to the guidance office**
- II. **Algebra 1 Credit Recovery & Algebra 1 EOC Prep ([Summer Bridge Registration Link](#))**
 - a. This program is for rising 10th-11th graders needing to retake Algebra 1 for grade forgiveness or to earn credit for a previously failed Algebra 1 class
 - b. Algebra 1 EOC Prep is for rising 10th graders who did not pass the Algebra 1 EOC and need to retake it
 - i. **June 21st -July 15th from 8:00a-12:00p**
 - ii. Algebra 1 EOC test dates: July 14th & 15th
- III. **ACT ELA Prep ([Summer Bridge Registration Link](#))**
 - a. Program is for rising 11th and 12th graders who need to earn a concordant ELA score to meet graduation requirements.
 - i. **June 21st -July 15th from 8:00a-12:00p**
 - ii. Current 12th graders needing a concordant score may also attend
 - b. ACT test is Saturday, July 17th
 - i. **Registration deadline June 18th**
 - ii. North County Testing Locations: Dunedin HS, Pinellas Gulf Coast (More may be announced later)
- IV. **ACT Math Prep ([Summer Bridge Registration Link](#))**
 - a. Program is for rising 11th and 12th graders who need to prepare to pass the standardized math assessment to meet graduation requirements.
 - b. **June 21st -July 15th from 8:00a-12:00p**
