- 1 VEHICLE PER Graduate and 4 guests, there is no cost for parking. PLEASE ARRIVE TOGETHER.

- At the appropriate time, students and guests (in 1 car) should arrive at Blue or Red Parking lot, park and remain in the car.

BLUE LOT (Is the SOUTH PARKING LOT for Spectrum Field - right off Drew Street)

RED LOT (Has a series of RED marked lots on the WEST SIDE of the Spectrum complex off of Old Coachman Road)

- At that lot, they will receive directions from SPECTRUM PARKING EMPLOYEES about how and when to move to the RED or BLUE GATE.
- We kindly ask our families to have the GRADUATE's NAME and SCHOOL NAME on their dashboard upon arrival at the Red or Blue parking lot.

- School Staff can park in the PARKING LOT off Drew Street (the lot we are calling the red lot, Spectrum calls it LOT D) All staff - Please arrive ½ hour prior at 3:30 pm.

- **DIPLOMA DISTRIBUTION:** We at Countryside mailed these out the first week of June. Anyone who did not receive theirs can contact the Principal at vicarir@pcsb.org

PROCESSIONAL CEREMONY FLOW: The STAGE PROCESS

NOTE: We will follow CDC guidelines, and the graduate and their guests will remain masked and socially distanced from others. Name Card distribution and Class of 2020 masks will be provided to graduates during the check-in process at the stadium entrance. Graduates and families will be escorted into the processional line all the way to the stage to the riser.

- **STUDENT ATTIRE:**

- FLAT SHOES (tennis shoes or flat sandals). Shoes will not be in graduation pictures
- Caps and Gowns: SCHOOLS CAN DECIDE what must be worn under the cap/gown (**reminder caps may not be decorated**)
- Students and guests may not carry any items into the parking lot or onto the field (ONLY guests may carry cell phones for pictures and filming)

- **PROCESSIONAL CEREMONY FLOW:**

- Stanchions will guide the path that graduates/guests will walk to the stage

- The readers will be located adjacent to the stage on either side, and the graduate will hand them their name card just prior to walking across the stage. The readers will be protected by plexiglass and grads will slide their cards under the glass for them to read
 - Graduate will then use stairs to raise to the riser (see bullet below for what family is doing)
 - WE NEED TO ENSURE Graduates know to just walk across stage to the stand displaying their diploma cover for a photo opportunity
- On the riser, there will be a stand. Grad will stop here, and GRAD PICTURE IS TAKEN AT THIS MOMENT.

Grads will have the option of removing their masks just for the picture. Principals will see marks on stage that will show where they may stand 6 or more feet away from any unmasked grads.

 - Marks will be on stage to depict 6 foot distances from where grad will be taking the grad picture to ensure safety
- Just prior to the graduate walking across the stage, the family will separate from the graduate, and stand in front of the stage as their graduate walks across.
 - The family will then rejoin their graduate on the other side of the stage, and then exit through the vehicle service entrance / exit on the first base side.
- Graduates and Guests will then be guided by stanchions and personnel to exit nearest their original gate of entry. Spectrum personnel will guide cars in exiting each parking lot.
