***Countryside High School
Senior Prom Rules/Policies***

*The Countryside High School Senior Prom will be held on April 21st, 2017, 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.
at The Safety Harbor Spa and Resort - Safety Harbor, Florida.*

*Cost of ticket includes: entrance to event, dinner and dessert, photo booth pictures,
as well a souvenir prom t-shirt*.*

Purchase of a prom ticket constitutes your agreement to abide by the following policies.

Tickets:

- To purchase tickets, you must be an 11th or 12th grader. You may only buy two tickets: one for you and one for your guest.
- What to bring: This form signed, and a current photo I.D. When buying a ticket for a guest, you must also present a copy of their current photo I.D. (CHS school I.D. card, driver's license, state I.D. card). The copies will be kept on record and must be clear, unmarked, and easy to read.
- Tickets must be bought with CASH ONLY. NO CHECKS.
- Tickets will be sold on the designated dates (WEDNESDAY AND FRIDAY ONLY WITH EXCEPTION OF WEEK OF PROM) during both lunches and after school (1:35 p.m.-2:20 p.m.) in the front office.
- On Wednesday March 8th, 2017 tickets will be sold for the lowest possible price at \$55.00.
- Tickets will be sold on March 22, 24th, 29th, 31st & April 5th and 7th for \$60.00.
- Tickets will be sold on April 12th and 13th for \$70.00.
- Tickets will be sold ALL DAY during Prom Court Elections, April 12th.
- The week of Prom: Monday, April 17th through Thursday, April 20th the tickets will be sold for \$80.00.
- NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AFTER 2:20 p.m. on Thursday, April 20, 2017.
- Guests must be at least a high school freshman and cannot be older than 21. (*The age 21 limit does not apply to current Countryside High juniors or seniors.*)
- Students, who are currently suspended, expelled or attending an alternative school cannot attend the prom. Early graduates may attend as guests only, and must adhere to the prom guidelines policies and PCSB rules.
- If your guest changes, you must change the guest name with Mrs. Gray or Ms. Coners by 2:20 p.m. on April 20, 2017. You must show your student I.D. and the new guest's copy of their I.D./license. (If you change your guest, you will not get another gift provided. It is your responsibility to personally exchange your gift with your new guest.)
- You may not swap or sell tickets. Only the student and the registered guest of those tickets will be admitted to the prom.
- YOU MUST PRESENT THESE ITEMS FOR ADMISSION TO THE PROM: your tickets, your I.D., and your guest's I.D.
- NO REFUNDS, on prom tickets will be given for any reason.

*Prom t-shirts sizes are available on a first come basis. The order of sizes is preset and no additional shirts will be ordered. If you have a particular size you would like, be sure to buy your prom ticket early on.

Attire and Conduct:

- Prom is a formal dress occasion. You will not be admitted to the prom unless you are dressed properly. Dresses should be of appropriate length, not above the thigh, nothing see through, no low plunging necklines. No shorts. No jeans, pants should be formal, khakis are allowed. Dress shirts should have a collar. Formal attire means “dressed up”.
- Dancing must remain appropriate to a school environment. Suggestive or dangerous dancing will be stopped and those participating may be removed from the premises.
- Students are responsible for the behavior of any invited guest.
- Once admitted to the prom, you will not be allowed to leave and re-enter. THIS INCLUDES GOING TO YOUR CAR.
- Students may not enter off-limits areas of the prom venue.
- Absolutely no tobacco, alcohol, or drugs of any nature are permitted at the prom. Any students under the influence of these items will be removed to their parent’s custody and school action will be taken (suspension, expulsion, or re-assignment).
- The parent(s) and student assume responsibility for any accident or property damage while attending and traveling to and from the prom.
- If a student is asked to leave by a chaperone or venue employee and refuses, the proper legal procedures will be followed.
- All rules and regulations of Countryside High School and Pinellas County Schools will be followed.
- The administrators of Countryside High School reserve the right to make any other decisions needed to ensure a safe night for our students.
- The Safety Harbor Resort and Spa has requested that no students or parents of students book a hotel room or stay in a hotel room at the resort on the night of April 21, 2017. This is a request that was set forth by The Safety Harbor Resort and Spa. Students and parents are kindly asked to adhere to this request
- All personal items such as cell phones, car keys, etc. are YOUR responsibility. Countryside High School and the prom venue are not responsible for lost personal property.

Return this form in order to purchase your tickets. Also, remember to bring your CHS I.D., cash, and the copy of the CHS I.D. or copy of driver’s license of your guest.
