Principals Report

Stakeholder Survey

- Survey results for stakeholder survey (parents) rated the schools over 90% with 52% of them rating the school overall as excellent.
- Most questions scored around 90% and trending in line with previous three years. While we are happy with the results, we have identified some opportunities for improvement. The full survey results will be available on the school website.
- Hollins had the highest number of staff completing the survey in the district.
- Approximately 300 surveys completed by parents against a goal of 20% of the student body

Sports

- Basketball – most wins in 30 years.
- Robotics – two teams qualified for States (58 teams go to the State tournament, Hollins is one of two in the district to make it.
- Hollins had the third highest amount of artwork awarded in the district for Scholastic Arts District Competition.
- JROTC – has not finished below 2nd place this year in any competition. No schools with a JROTC program are in the top 10 for the district – our finishes are very impressive.
- Wrestling – Top 3 going to PCAC, districts will be coming up and some are expected to qualify to move on.

Testing Strategy

- Testing (May) – focused effort will be made to test 95% of students in one week, with one test per day, and in one building. This will limit distractions and create more focus on the “testing center” set up to promote student success and eliminate distractions. Other festivities will be added (food, music, etc.) to make the experience more “fun” and enjoyable (less stressful). Testing week will be 5/6/2024-5/10/2024. Historically, the numbers of tests taken beyond the first week have shown a decrease in participation – so the focus will be to get as many of the 95% tested during this week.

New Business – funding request made that may not qualify under the SAC funding guidelines. Mr. Florio will follow up with the teacher and give them an opportunity to modify request or seek funding in an alternate way.

Unfinished Business – Discussion around the student rights and responsibilities group and how that group will be working through decisions around restrictions for students having cell phones. While teachers want to limit distractions, they also don’t want to be held responsible for student devices. No determination has been made at the district level yet.
