

## Our campus has sixteen instructional buildings:

- Building 1, 2 and 3 are in what we call the 100 wing and are closest to the gym, student parking and Band/Choral Rooms
- Building 5, 6 and 7 are in the 200 wing this wing is the closest to our main courtyard, Cafeteria and Media Center
- \*Most of your ELA, Math, Reading, Social Studies and AVID classes will be in these two wings and buildings
- Building 8 houses all our Business Education classes
- Building 9 is our Cafeteria
- Building 10 is our Media Center
- Building 11 houses all Academy of Entertainment Art classes
- Building 13 is our Auditorium and home to all Theater classes
- Building 14 is our Gymnasium
- Building 15 is our Culinary Academy106
- Building 16 is our JROTC Program and classes
- Building 30 houses our Band and Choral classes
- Building 32 is our only two-story building
- Lower level is ESE classes and upper level is all science classes
- Buildings 18 and 19 are the Guidance and Administration offices

**School Supplies**: Hollins High School has a school store. The store will not be open until the beginning of September since it is staffed by students with Teacher supervision. Hours will be during lunch on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1:30 to 2 pm and on Wednesday mornings from 6:30 to 7 am. Individual classroom supplies will be communicated by individual teachers on the opening days of school.
