- A reminder as we start the fourth quarter, that each quarter and final exam make up roughly a third of a student's semester grade. It is important for students to finish their academic year strong
 - We will continue our Extended Learning Program from 2 to 3 pm Monday through Thursday in our Media Center and online for our virtual learners. All students can receive tutoring, test preparation and homework assistance in all core academic areas
