Community Tampa Bay presents 2020-21 "Student Leadership Conferences for Pinellas County Schools High Schools"

Students have the right to attend a school where all racial, ethnic, and cultural heritages are welcome and respected. Through the efforts of the Principal's Multicultural Advisory Committee (PMAC), schools will see improvement in their school climate in hopes that all students see **their school as a place of belonging**. The Community Tampa Bay Student Leadership Conferences are an integral part of this process to help students work in collaboration as school leaders to achieve this goal of belonging for all students. Through these conferences, students become stakeholders involved in the school's equity work as leaders and advocates of more equitable outcomes for all learners.

All high schools will participate in student leadership conferences. Each school will have 40 student participants (10 from each grade level). The conferences will be run in two sessions from 7:30-10:30 (9th/10th grade), and 10:30-1:30 (11th/12th grade). These sessions will occur outdoors with groups of no more than 20 students in each session.

Schools will choose students to ensure an equal mixture of different races that is easily visually evident and a mixture of students with varying behavioral concerns and lack thereof. Wherever possible, please also include students who are in PMAC and attended last year's Unity Walk. If your PMAC Liaison or Equity Champion is non-classroom based, they can be present for the student-led conference.
