Dixie Hollins High School Tardy Policy

Attendance is the number one predictor of student success! Please have your student in school every day, on time, dressed for success and ready to learn. We appreciate it. Working together we can and will reach all of our goals.

Once a student is on campus – it is imperative that they get to class on time to maximize their learning.

Tardy Policy: Attendance is very important. Any student not in class when the bell rings is tardy. Students are permitted to be late to school five times in a quarter for their first class of the day. Additionally, due to the amount of time allowed between each class, student cannot be late to subsequent classes or will receive a tardy, resulting in an after-school detention.

Detentions: Detentions are one hour after school in the cafeteria Monday or Wednesday from 2:15 to 3:15pm. Failure to serve a detention will result in double detention either Tuesday or Thursday whichever day is following their previously scheduled missed one hour detention.

Double Detention: Double Detention is two hours after school in the cafeteria from 2:15 to 4:15pm. Failure to serve double detention will result in an Alternative Bell Schedule (ABS).

Alternative Bell Schedule: ABS runs from 2:30 to 6:00pm. Students attend ABS in lieu of attending the regular school day. It is an alternative to suspension.
