Information Needed to Apply:

- Application must be completed online. Each student must have access to their own computer whether they are on campus or attending school from home using PCS Virtual. .
- The following information will be asked of your students to have available in order to complete the application and satisfy the in-state residency requirements to receive in-state tuition:

- **AT LEAST TWO ID numbers of the following from a PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN:**

St. Petersburg College will be extending the time to complete the application with the application fee waiver for the entire week of November 4th through November 11th!

Simply click or go to this link (<http://now.spc.edu/forseniors>) and complete the standard application or the supplemental application. Most students will complete the standard application. If you are currently in dual enrollment or have ever signed up for dual enrollment, you will be completing the supplemental application. There is an SPC ID number look up tool for those students who must complete the supplemental application and do not know their student number. **Once the application is completed, click step 2 for the application waiver form** and fill in the necessary information. This is necessary to ensure the application fee is waived!

Since everyone will be doing the application and waiver on their own, a support line has been created for those who have questions or concerns while doing so. Unlike a business office number, there will be someone available at this number any time. **Texts will be the easiest way to connect** but calls will be responded to after a message is left if it is not picked up at the time of the call.
