- Report cards will be distributed on Tuesday April 20th along with Principal list certificates and Honor Roll certificates
- Our school board has again waived the attendance requirement for exempting spring exams. Absences will not count against a student. All other requirements are in effect. Students must maintain the letter grade of “A” or “B”- the number of classes exempted is the same and the semester senior exam policy remains
