 - Students need to score a level 3 or better to be considered proficient and meet the state graduation requirement. We ask you to help your student be rested, prepared and ready to do their best
 - Our mission is to be the best public high school in the state – if every one of our student’s try their best on any and all examinations, they take this spring we can and will accomplish that goal
