# Ready, Set...Kindergarten

Mark your calendar for Wednesday, February 7, 2024 at 5:00pm in the Media Center.

If you have a child who will be five years old prior to September 1, 2024, you can register your child at your zoned PCS elementary school or join us on February 7<sup>th</sup>.

- Your child must be 5 years old by 9/1/24
- Be able to show proof of residency (2 recent and different utilities with home address)
- Have an orginial Birth Certificate
- Have a Florida Certificate of Immunization
- Have a physical examination certificate, within a year of starting Kindergarten.

# <u>Stay Informed</u>

Parents, please take a few minutes to sign into your parent account through the Student Reservation System to update your phone number, and/or address. Important Skycrest and Pinellas County updates are automatically sent to the phone number listed in Focus. Calls made, include: when school closes due to weather, events, and student absences. Text messages are now being sent to all mobile phone numbers.

## <u>Leader in Me</u>

Habit 5: Seek First to Understand, Then to be Understood

Purpose: seeking first to understand, then to understand means it is better to listen first and then talk.

Family Activity: Practice with this habit by introducing listening to others speak first. Then we can take our turn to talk or explain ourselves. When having conflict with your child, model this skill by asking "Tell me your point of view". After listening to your child paraphrase what they said and respond in a respectful manner.
