





School Safety Reminders:

<p style="text-align: center;">ERIP</p> 	<p>ERIP (Emergency Response Information Portal) ERIP is where all our resources regarding school safety and security are located.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School and district emergency plans • Drill schedules, and after-action reports • Monthly safety reports (no more paper copies) • Safety eLearning courses: FEMA, Active Threat Response, Stop the Bleed. • Resources for Active Threat Drills, Threat Assessments, Hurricane Shelters, etc. <p>www.erip.com *ERIP is also in Clever and the PCS Staff Portal</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Campus Visitors</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents are allowed to walk their children to class from August 14th-16th. • Beginning Monday, August 19th, parents will no longer be allowed to escort their children to the classrooms. • <i>We do not want long lines of frustrated parents the first days of school trying to check in with the visitor management system, but that does not mean it's unstructured. The SSO and all non-classroom staff should be very visible, and keeping parents where they are supposed to be, with a clear time when the campus needs to be cleared out of visitors.</i> <p>Ident-a-Kid: (guides located in ERIP resources) Our new visitor management system should take the guess work out of signing visitors in at your school. Every school had a front office representative trained in the system and should have a basic understanding of the system. If there are any questions or concerns, please contact Dennis Russo as we roll this out.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Active Threat Drills</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any questions about our Active Threat Drills/Protocols please email Dennis Russo. • If any of your staff did not participate in the Preschool Active Assailant training, they must take the online Active Threat Response course in ERIP. • The Active Threat Drill Guides for administrators and teachers are located in ERIP. • The only people that should know the time/date of Active Threat Drills or Fire Drills is a small circle of people. <p style="text-align: center;">Classroom</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All classroom doors must remain locked and latched when students are present, and class is in session. • No secondary locking devices shall be used on classroom doors. • Safe Places must be marked in each classroom, by HPO and SRO/SSO. • Safe Places must be free of non-movable furniture. Student desks and small tables are movable, teacher desks and heavily file cabinets are not movable. • Each classroom should have an opaque covering that may be quickly applied to the classroom door's window in response of an active threat on campus.
