## Semester 2 Welcome/Day 1 Procedures

First of all, I hope that everyone had an amazing holiday season and are well-rested and ready for a great second half of the 2022-23 school year! Tomorrow, Monday, January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2023, marks the first day of semester 2. Students will go directly to their 1<sup>st</sup> period class as the usual start of the school day, which is at 7:25am. As students are enrolled in some semester courses or may have had a schedule adjustment due to enrollment fluctuations, it is imperative that students sign into Focus and verify their schedules <u>tonight (Sunday, January 8<sup>th</sup>)</u>, prior to the start of the school day. We will also have staff members available in Student Services, Guidance, and the front office to assist at the start of the school day in case your student has a new 1<sup>st</sup> period but isn't sure where it is located. If you and/or your student has any questions or concerns regarding their schedule, please don't hesitate to reach out to your student's counselor and/or Assistant Principal.

## **Senior Scholarship Opportunities**
