#### **Concordant Score Testing – Juniors and Seniors**

Starting this week, we will have several testing opportunities for juniors and seniors that are still in need of a testing concordant score for graduation. Students requiring either their FSA/FAST ELA or Algebra 1 EOC concordance will sit for the Classic Learning Test this Thursday first thing in the morning, followed by some additional testing opportunities throughout the month.

#### In-School SAT – Juniors

All juniors will sit for the FREE in-school SAT on Wednesday, March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Students will test using their school issued laptops utilizing the Bluebook application. This is a free testing opportunity that is available to all juniors that can be used for A) testing concordance, B) college admissions, and/or C) Bright Futures.

#### Prom, Senior Breakfast, and Graduation Reminders

This year, Prom will take place on Friday, March 22<sup>nd</sup> at Ruth Eckerd Hall. More information surrounding tickets will be announced as we move through the month of February.

Senior breakfast will take place on Monday, April 29<sup>th</sup> this year.
