Upcoming Testing

This week all 9th and 10th grade students will participate in the BEST Writing Assessment. All 9th grade will test on April 9 while all 10th grade will test on April 10 first thing in the morning. They should find their name on the testing locators as early as Monday at lunch. They will use their school issue laptops.

To ensure that all 9th and 10th grade students are with all of their teachers at least one of the two testing days, we will be flipping the class period schedule on Wednesday, April 10th, meaning that we will begin the day with 7th period and end of the day with 1st period on Wednesday, April 10th only. The bell schedule will be as follows:

- 5th Period = 9:11 9:58am
- 4^{th} Period = 10:03 10:50am

At the start of the school day on the 9th and 10th, students that are testing (9th on April 9th; 10th on April 10th) will go directly to their testing location. If your student has a Dual Enrollment course in the afternoon that will cause them to be impacted by this change on Wednesday, please reach out to your Assistant Principal.

Additionally, standardized testing for AICE, Advanced Placement, FAST, and End of Course exams are fast approaching. Students will wrap up new content and review for all of this upcoming testing throughout the month of April.
