# May Testing Strategy Updates – FAST ELA PM3 and EOCs

Parents, the FAST ELA assessment and Algebra 1/Geometry EOCs have shifted to adaptive question testing, so some of the testing strategies that teachers are working with students in the classroom to prepare have shifted from previous years. Attached to the email you'll find some OnePagers that outline how students are preparing for May testing, starting with the FAST ELA PM3 assessment that all 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will take on May 2<sup>nd</sup> (9<sup>th</sup> grade) and May 3<sup>rd</sup> (10<sup>th</sup> grade). We'll send out detailed reminders on these strategies in the weeks to come to families so that you can reinforce this at home and use it as a discussion around testing.
