As a reminder, we expect students to be back to our usual dress code expectations on Tuesday and moving forward. ## • Transportation Reminders:

- If your student rides the bus to or from school, please be sure your student arrives at their bus stop at least ten minutes prior to the scheduled pickup time in the morning. After a bus arrives and leaves, it will not return. Busses are also unable to stop further along their route to pick up a student who is late. Additionally, students are not allowed to ride a bus they are not assigned to this could result in disciplinary action for your student. As of now, East Lake only has one route without an assigned driver, but it has been covered regularly! Take the stress out of getting your student to school and leave the driving to PCSB Transportation!
- While Transportation is doing well covering our routes at East Lake, there are multiple opportunities throughout the school district for bus drivers and bus assistants. If you, a relative, neighbor or friend are interested in driving, PCSB will train and assist in earning a Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL). There are also almost 50 bus assistant jobs available

throughout the county, assisting students as they enter and exit the bus.
