### **December Testing**

Finally, we have multiple testing dates coming up in the next three weeks. Next week (week of 12/5), all of our US Government students will be sitting for the Florida Civic Literacy Exam. Remember that this is a great opportunity for students to meet the post-secondary civic literacy requirement before even graduating high school, along with an opportunity for it to count as their midterm grade pending how well they do.

On December 13<sup>th</sup> we will be facilitating the F.A.S.T. Progress Monitoring 2 assessment for all 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students. We will send out more specific information regarding the F.A.S.T. PM2 next week regarding testing logistics – please remind your students it is vital to put their best effort forth and show the growth they've made since the start of the school year. Teachers will use that data to work closely with students to continue that growth as we work through semester 2.

During the week of December 19<sup>th</sup>, we will facilitate the semester 1 midterm exams. Students that qualify will receive exam exemption forms during the week of December  $12^{th}$  – you should expect a specific callout with that information in the future. Remember that to qualify, students must have an A or B during Q1 and a provision grade of an A or B during Q2, along with having no more than 4 absences in any single period.
