- 3.0 **unweighted** GPA
- qualifying test scores (PERT, SAT, or ACT)
- SPC ID #

If a student meets this criteria, they **\*MUST\*** contact their counselor to complete and submit the dual enrollment Permission Form to SPC. Students cannot self-enroll.

- The deadline for fall enrollment is June 9, 2021.
