Upcoming Testing

School-Issued Laptop Renewal Process

The district has pushed an icon with the blue/green/yellow torch titled Student Device Self-Renewal. Double-click on this icon and it will bring up the renewal prompt. Once this new window opens there is a green button which says, "Renew Device Checkout". If all of the paperwork is in place and the current device is assigned to your student, the renewal will be successful.
