If your student doesn't have an exam during the second half of the day because they qualified for an exemption or it is an Advanced Placement/AICE/EOC course (Algebra 1/Geometry/Biology/US History) and you allow them to leave for the day after the first exam block, please call or email ahead of time to get a Permit to Leave for your student. Students will need to stay in their testing site during the entire testing block and will not be permitted to leave campus during each exam period, which will consist of review and testing. Locker Cleanout, Book Return, and Laptop Renewal
