Tomorrow (5/4/2021) we continue with day 2 of our 10th grade FSA reading test. Here is the schedule for the rest of the week. Remember, day two of the test is a flipped schedule (tomorrow and Thursday) and testing begins at 7:25 for our face-to-face students. MyPCS students will test at beginning at 10:50 (arrive at 10:30).

May 4th – 10th grade face to face student testing (part 2). Bell schedule – 7,6,5,4,3,2,1 test starts at 7:25 AM
10th grade MyPCS students will come in at 10:30 AM to test

May 5th – 9th grade face to face student testing (part 1). Bell schedule – 1,2,3,4,5,6,7 test starts at 7:25 AM
9th grade MyPCS students will come in at 10:30 AM to test

May 6th – 9th grade face to face student testing (part 2). Bell schedule - 7,6,5,4,3,2,1 test starts at 7:25 AM
9th grade MyPCS students will come in at 10:30 AM to test

Students must take both parts for the test to count. Remember, our 9th and 10th grade students still need to pass this test as part of their graduation requirement.

AP testing has also begun. Please check with your student for the dates of their AP exams. I trust they know when they are testing! If not, please email their AP teacher or ask your student to speak with their AP teacher as soon as possible.
