I wanted to let you know there is an opportunity for your student to re-take any End-of-Course assessment next week which they may not have been successful on in the spring. These include, Algebra 1, Biology, Geometry and U.S. History. The FSA Reading and Writing Assessment will NOT be administered in July, but rising 11th graders will be able to retake this graduation required assessment in September if they achieved a level 1 or 2 in May. All State End-of-Course exam grades have been posted by the district into FOCUS and are viewable by you.

If you wish for your student to take a test, they should arrive at school by 8:15 on Monday July 11. Coach Delk will assist getting them tested. Algebra 1 and Geometry are both two-day tests, so your student will need to be here Monday and Tuesday morning.
