Weekly Progress Reports and Tardy Communication

I will begin sending weekly progress reports every Wednesday beginning the second full week of each semester. You can expect this to begin Wednesday, August 23rd. If your student was at East Lake High School last semester, you're familiar with the Student Conductor tardy system that we use at the school. We plan to begin utilizing that system this week and will communicate reminders to families prior to the first day. Students have received reminders on the expectation and policy this week as well.

Parent Car Loop/Student Parking Lot

As we move into next week, there are a few parking reminders that are relevant to families and students which will assist with flow and safety. Parents, please remember that our parent car circle has two lanes – ensure that if you are entering from Bryan Lane, please use the right lane, and if you are entering from Silver Eagle Drive going north, please use the left lane of the parent loop. Additionally, please have your students exit the car along the football stadium and student parking lot, prior to reaching the crosswalk. All students must use the crosswalk that is monitored by East Lake HS and MS staff. Additionally, parents will need to follow the parent car loop throughout the lot – please do not attempt to exit through the student parking lot. All of these will assist with flow and safety both for arrival and dismissal.

We will continue to collaborate with the middle school to determine whether any adjustments need to be made. We appreciate your patience as we start a new year! Parents, please remind students to drive safely and always abide by all school and roadway expectations.
