Good Evening Eagle Families,

Thank you for a successful opening week. The carline is starting to work better every day. We are awaiting the arrival of additional traffic cones which will further assist having two lanes all of the way through. As a safety concern and to clarify, if you are dropping off on the right side of the drive closest to the football stadium, your student should utilize that sidewalk to walk towards the school. If dropping off on the left side, your student should use the sidewalk on the left side closest to the driver's side door and walk towards the crosswalk where they may cross safely.

The opening of school as always presents itself with unknowns. As Mr. Poth sent to families on Friday, with the tragic loss of one of our students our thoughts continue to be with the family and how best to help them work through this tragedy. Grief and mental health counselors have been on campus since students arrived on Wednesday morning and throughout the remainder of the week. They have worked with individual students, visited classrooms and have met with student groups as needed. With so many attending the memorial to say their final goodbyes over the weekend, mental health professionals will remain on campus at East Lake and be available to any student or staff member for as long as they are needed.

Morning Arrival Safety and a change to early morning student arrival

- The front parking lot is for busses only, and the south parking lot for teachers and staff. No other vehicles should enter either parking lot.
- The gates to the campus will remain locked until 6:50am. Gates to enter the campus will remain closed and locked until staff arrive for morning arrival and open them. This is a change from past practice and we along with our law enforcement partners feel it will continue to improve the safety of the East Lake campus for everyone.

11th Graders – October PSAT (Registration closes this week)

This test is given annually to all 9th and 10th graders and scores directly correlate to the SAT. Juniors have the opportunity to test and qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program. They can use the link below to access a Microsoft Form to register. They will need to be signed into their Office 365 account to register.

- There is ZERO cost to take this test and attempt to qualify for scholarships.

- <u>The Deadline to register is Thursday August 18, 2:00pm</u>. There is no ability to register a student after this deadline as the information will be automatically sent to College Board, so please have your student Opt-In early!
