Good Evening Eagle Families,

Please read this email all the way through as we prepare for the new student drop off and pick up process beginning Monday. Please review the map of our school below here: <https://tinyurl.com/ELHSNewDropOff8-23-21>

Dropping off and Picking up of students:

The red arrows and red text indicate the new drop off and pick up route for parents. Parents will enter the student drop off line at **Gate 3** (closest to Bryan Lane). They will proceed all the way to the area close to the football field and area in front of the gym (indicated by the “car drop off” area on the map) and drop off their students. Parents will exit at **Gate 1** (making a right turn).

Pick up will follow the same route. To accommodate those families who wish to arrive early, we will open the gates at 1 PM.

Please be patient. We know it will take time for everyone to learn the new process, but in the end, the traffic patterns will improve.

Student drivers:

The blue arrows and blue text indicate the student driver route. Students will enter at **Gate 2** and proceed to a parking spot. Students may not park in a senior reserved spot (lot to the left of center closest to the school) if they have not purchased a senior reserved spot. Also, please make sure your student has purchased their parking permit through Rev Trak and to remember to display their hang tag. Our deputies and staff will safely cross the students onto the campus. At the end of the school day, students will exit at **Gate 2** and turn right.

Bus riders – No changes.

We will have school staff available both before and after school to help parents and students follow the correct routes
