Good afternoon East Lake families,

Week 2 is in the books, and we had a fantastic week at the Lake.

I hope all our parents know how well of a job you're doing. Your students are awesome kids. I have enjoyed our interactions on campus and getting to them more and more each day.

As always, we have a lot of information to cover. Please review my email carefully and thoroughly.

Open House:

- Please review my email communication from early this week regarding the details of Open House on Tuesday 8/26, 4:30-6:30.
 - o Arrive at your convenience and visit classrooms, meet teachers, and access information in the media center (see below)
 - Counselors Corner
 - Admin Q+A
 - Focus and Tech support
 - Athletic information
 - Map your schedule
 - o This is not intended to be a conference night. If you wish to have a more in-depth discussion regarding your student, please request to schedule a later date/time with the teacher.

Tardies:

- Recording of tardies per period has started. You should have received an email through the student conductor system if your student was tardy.
- Remember, if a student is late for class, they will have to report to a tardy station/kiosk and enter their lunch pin (see attached map for tardy station/kiosk locations).
- Tardies follow a progressive disciplinary pattern:
 - o 1st-3rd warning, minor infraction, parent contact
 - 4th-5th lunch detention, parent contact
 - o 6th-7th after-school detention, parent contact
 - \circ 8th 1 day consequence IC, parent contact
 - 9th 2-3 days consequence IC/ABS, parent contact conference
 - 10th Parent conference
- VERY IMPORTANT: Please address getting to class on time with your student.

Cell Phones and Headphones:

- Cellphones are only allowed before/after school and during lunch.
 - o Phones and other electronic devices (e.g. headphones, smart watch) must be turned off and put away during instructional time.
 - o A teacher may approve device use but this will be rare.
 - Strategic Communications / Power Up (pcsb.org)
- Headphones are not allowed to be used during instructional time. They may be used at lunch.
- We have had several students wearing their headphones in the hallway during class transitions. Students need to be able to hear information and directives during class transitions. Please discuss this with your student to put away their headphones.

Dress Code:

- Please review the dress code (see example slide in Opening Day PowerPoint on the school website)
 - o Dress code will be enforced. Please discuss the dress code with your student and check daily their attire.
 - For both boys and girls, key issues with dress code so far have been tank tops, shirts that do
 not cover the stomach, shorts that are too short (past mid-thigh) & spandex shorts.

Student Passwords:

- A reminder to students to use a secure password to access your PCSB R2.D2 account. There have been several instances already this year where student passwords have been compromised.
- Do not use your student number, School name or mascot, favorite teacher's name, or anything easy to figure out as part of your password. Also do not share your password under any circumstances.
- If you feel your account has been compromised, let a teacher know as quickly as possible and change your password. If you need assistance, let an administrator know. Ultimately, you are responsible for all activity linked to your student account.

Absences and Permission to Leave (PTL):

- We have made the process of reporting absences and PTLs much easier. On our school site (at the very top), there is a link that says, "Report Student Absence." It will take you to a page that you can report an absence or request a PTL.
- Click the appropriate link and you will complete a brief form and we take care of the rest. No need to call or email anymore.

School Entry/Exit & Safety:

- Gates open at 7:00 AM along with the Cafeteria
 - o Buildings and classrooms open at 7:15 AM
 - o 5-minute warning bell at 7:20 AM
 - o 1-minute warning bell at 7:24 AM
- Doors remain locked during the day per safety policy following the 7:25 AM start bell.
 - o Students are to never prop open doors or let anyone in on campus.
 - o Late arrivals must enter through the front office.
- All virtual and dual enrollment students coming on to campus either 2nd, 3rd, or 4th period must enter through the front gate by the main office.

- All virtual and dual enrollment students that are leaving campus anytime after 4th period, must exit through the front gate by the main office.
 - To maintain campus safety, we are enforcing a single point of entry and exit during the school day. Students must use only the main gate by the front office unless there is an emergency.
 - We understand that the north gate may be more convenient for accessing the parking lot; however, using unauthorized exits poses a security risk. An open/propped gate or allowing someone to enter through an unmonitored access point, compromises the safety of everyone on campus.
 - Disciplinary consequences will be issued to students that leave through unauthorized gates and/or open the gate for other students or adults.
 - Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our school secure.

Car line (drop off and pick up):

- Follow traffic patterns as instructed.
 - o PM: have your student cross and walk down the walkway to find your car. Several cars wait to pick up at the crosswalk near the front and this causes a break in the flow of traffic.
- All drop off and pickups need to move through the car line.
 - o Please <u>DO NOT</u> drop off in neighborhoods, in the student parking lot, or on the side of the road.
- Leave a little earlier to ensure you get to school on-time.
 - School will start at 7:25am and the north gates will close to all students to maintain security of our campus.
 - o All late arriving students will report to the front gate at the main office.

- *Don't forget...Pinellas County Athletics is rolling out season ticket packages. We have non-football all sports packages and football packages available through GoFan.co
 - These new ticket packages are replacing the family pass option. Packages include individual tickets that will be validated at the gate.
 - Example: 10 ticket packages, patrons can use 1 ticket per event or bring a family of 5 and would then validate 5 tickets of the 10-ticket package which leaves 5 left over from the package.

Free-Reduced Lunch:

- If your child had an approved free/reduced meal status last year, it will expire on Sept. 23.
 - o A new application must be submitted for the 2025-26 school year to continue receiving meal benefits.
 - o If a new application is not submitted, then, beginning Sept. 24, your student will need to pay for lunch.
- All students at East Lake High School are eligible to receive a free breakfast every day with no application needed.

- We encourage all families who believe they may be eligible to apply. There are additional scholarship funds and assistance available for standardized testing fees for students from qualifying families.
