Opening Day:

Please do not drop your student off in the student or teacher parking lots as it is unsafe.

If you are a bus rider, please be at your stop at least ten minutes before your scheduled pick up time. Be patient as the first few weeks buses are adjusting exact pick up times.

Students will receive valuable information to bring home during homeroom. Please review all the information and return signed forms to first period teachers by August 23.

Please visit our website where you will find our new bell schedule as well as additional valuable information. Please be aware the schedule you see for your student today may differ by Wednesday morning, so it is important for your student to pick up their schedule in the morning.
