If you checked out a device from Pinellas County Schools and you are trying to add a printer to it here are the steps.

In order to add a printer to a computer you received from the school, the student (or parent) must login into Clever and find the Tech Help icon. Click on the icon and submit a tech help ticket explaining your desire to add a printer to a school computer at home. You must provide the printer make and model as well as the property tag number of the computer. This is a 7-digit number found on a sticker on the bottom of the computer and looks like: 314-1234
