### **Upcoming Testing Opportunities**

Due to the storm we have adjusted school-wide testing dates for September. All 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will take the FAST ELA PM1 assessment next week. Freshmen are scheduled to test on Tuesday, September 12<sup>th</sup>, and sophomores are scheduled to test on Wednesday, September 13<sup>th</sup>. All students will test at the start of 2<sup>nd</sup> period through 4<sup>th</sup> period, and they will learn about where they'll test this week.

We will also have testing opportunities for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students who still need to meet a concordant score in either their ELA and/or Algebra 1 testing requirements needed for graduation. If your student needs one or both – these testing dates were shifted to begin on Wednesday 9/20. Families of students impacted will receive separate reminder callouts beginning after Labor Day.

Additionally, if your student didn't pass their EOC testing (Geometry, Biology, US History) but are looking to achieve Scholar Designation on their diploma, they can sign up for one of our retake opportunities in September. Have them reach out to their counselor if they are interested.

# Modified Bell Schedule – Friday, September 8th

Like last school year, students will test using their school issued laptop. To ensure that they are ready to go, we will be modifying the bell schedule to extend 4<sup>th</sup> period on Friday, September 8<sup>th</sup> to allow a short period of time for teachers to log into the county testing platform and troubleshoot any issues they may encounter prior to our upcoming testing dates.
