Criteria for application are:

- Currently a junior or senior in high school
- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- Completed 50 hours of volunteer service with ToyMakers of East Lake between June 2024 and May 2025.

Applications must include:

- Completed application form (attached)
- Photograph of applicant
- Two letters of recommendation
- Documentation of current GPA
- Written essay to include:
 - Why you are applying for this scholarship
 - Education and/or career objectives
 - Anticipated use of the money (tuition, room/board, books)
 - Personal achievements (awards, volunteer work, job, clubs, athletics, etc.)

You may email, mail, or deliver to the toy shop your application package. Again, applications must be received no later than March 31, 2025.
