Attendance:

Attendance is an important component to the success of any program. This is especially true of the STEM Explorer Club which consists of weekly building, coding, design challenges and other activities within the engineering design process. Due to an overwhelming interest in the STEM Explorer Program and the rigor of the planned activities, students are expected to attend each club session. If a student receives **3** or more unexcused absences, they may be dismissed from the STEM Explorer Club.

Arrival and Dismissal:

Our STEM Explorer Club facilitators are passionate about STEM and your child; and to honor their commitment to teaching and familial obligations we ask that all students (explorers) are dropped off or picked up promptly at the beginning or conclusion of each STEM Explorer Club session.

Family Involvement (Science Showcase and STEM Expo):

In Spring, students enrolled in the STEM Explorer Program will receive an invitation to attend and present at Pinellas County School's annual **free** Science Showcase and STEM Expo. The time, date and location for May 2023 event will be announced soon. Additional information will be provided later in the year.

Behavior:

The expectation of each student is to follow all Pinellas County School and STEM Explorer Club facilitators expectations for behavior to ensure a safe, fun, and engaging program.
