  - Algebra 1 (if enrolled after 2010-2011)
  - Biology 1 (if enrolled after 2010-2011)
  - Geometry (if enrolled after 2010-2011)
  - U.S. History (if enrolled after 2011-2012)

#### Weighted vs. Unweighted

- Weighted considers rigor of course
  - Honors: +.5 credit weight (max 4.5 GPA)
  - AP or Dual Enrollment: +1 credit (max 5.0 GPA)
- Your GPA is the single most important factor that colleges look at for admissions
  - Average weighted GPA for:
    - USF = 4.1 4.3
    - FSU = 4.1 4.5
    - UF = 4.3 4.6





## **BF Scholarship Requirements**

- Coursework Requirements for BOTH
- 16 course credits that align with the State University System (SUS) admission requirements.
  - 4 English (3 must include substantial writing)
  - 4- Mathematics (at or above Algebra 1 level) \*NOT Liberal Arts
  - 3- Natural Science (2 must have substantial laboratory)
  - 3- Social Science
  - 2- World Language (sequential, in same language)

#### **Florida Academic (100% tuition)**

- 3.5 Weighted BF GPA
- \*ACT 29 or SAT 1330
- 100 service hours

#### **Florida Medallion (75% tuition)**

- 3.0 Weighted BF GPA
- \*ACT 25 or SAT 1210
- 75 service hours
