How I use CANVAS:

Make-Up/Missing Work Policy:

Make-up/missing work is accepted up until the end of each grading period. Full credit can be achieved, but demerits will be issued if an assignment is not turned in on time. They cannot be removed.

Homework Details:

Homework will most often be completed in science journals and the science journal assignment will need to be signed directly. Homework will be no less than once a week.

Tests/Quizzes:

A test will be taken at the end of each unit. Quizzes may be given during class, and notes taken in class can be used for quizzes.

Success Tips:

If you are struggling in one of these areas, here are some helpful tips!

Organization

Write down homework in agenda within first 5 minutes of class. Keep science notebook organized and keep up with assignments and classwork. Ask if you don't know or need help!

Absences

How I use CANVAS:

Unit modules will contain some, but not all, of our course's assignments, quizzes, submissions, etc. DUE dates and CLOSE dates are to be noted by students. Digital copies of our syllabus, timelines, etc. are posted in the class module.

How I use FOCUS:

FOCUS will contain students' grades for all assignments. This is where a student can see their ACTUAL UPDATED grades, NOT in canvas.

Make-Up/Missing Work Policy:

Make up is allowed for students with excused absences. Missing work can be made up and turned in up to a week late. However, a penalty of of a grade deduction is applied. .

Homework Details:

Homework normally consists of continuing projects or assignments that have a due date beyond one day. Most assignments in canvas fall into this category.

Unit tests will be given after each unit. A midterm and final exam will also take place. Quizzes and formative assessments will occur in between tests.

How I use CANVAS:

I use Canvas to post the daily agendas, notes, classwork and homework. While the same information can be found in class, this will provide a backup for students that are absent or have fallen behind. Most work will be submitted through Canvas

How I use FOCUS:

Focus will reflect the student's actual grade in class (do not refer to Canvas). Occasionally I leave notes in Focus to inform students and parents of issues with the marked assignment.

Make-Up/Missing Work Policy:

Students must ask for missed work when they return from an absence. A grade listed as "M" is a missing assignment and will have a failing grade until completed! If work is more than a week late, 20% will be deducted from the final grade. I will make every reasonable accommodation to get a student caught up.

Homework Details:

Students will have homework 2-3 nights a week most times.

Homework will be posted in class on the white board, as well as in Canvas.

Tests/Quizzes:

Students will be given at least a week notice before a scheduled test/quiz. I may occasionally make use of pop-quizzes.

Success Tips:

If you are struggling in one of these areas, here are some helpful tips!

Organization

Your student will be creating an interactive science notebook. It will contain some daily work, assignments, labs and notes. This information is always current, so that the student's progress can be tracked. The students will keep a running table of contents, so that they will know exactly which pages they are missing. Motivation

How I use CANVAS:

My Canvas course is organized by subtopics and by dates. My goal is to upload all PowerPoints, rubrics, handouts and assignments in **Canvas**. Some assignments are not turned in on Canvas, but I try to place those dates online for reference. Please check there for special announcements as well.

How I use FOCUS:

Focus dates will mirror dates in **Canvas** and this is where grades will be posted. I try to also list demerits in Focus, but those might not be up to date immediately.

Make-Up/Missing Work Policy:

Students who are absent should check **Canvas** for missing work. I do take late work up until a date approximately two weeks before the end of the quarter. This date will be announced. Late work will be deducted 10%. If you see an M in Focus this means I am waiting for the work to be turned in until the close of the opportunity to turn in late work.

Homework Details:

Look for homework in **Canvas**. It may be assigned once or twice a week. Students should email me in **Canvas** with questions prior to the due date and allow enough time for my response. For example, questions asked after school is out or the night before will not be answered before the work is due at 9 am.

Tests/Quizzes:

U.S. History has a mid-term and a final exam. Students will have a review session prior to the exam and materials will be posted in Canvas.

There is no final exam for advanced academics. However, students do complete an independent project.

Course: U.S. History /Advanced Academics



Success Tips:

If you are struggling in one of these areas, here are some helpful tips!

Organization

- Use your planner/agenda and use **Canvas** as backup in case I am unable to post. Bring your charger.
- Check **Canvas** for rubrics, PowerPoints and copies of handouts you might have lost
- Complete your work prior to the deadline and before the last minute
- Learn to access the **Canvas** calendar to see upcoming due dates

How I use CANVAS:

How I use FOCUS:

Focus will be used to track grades and Demerits

Students will be alerted when an assignments/details will be posted on Portal.

Make-Up/Missing Work Policy:

No late work will be accepted unless the student is absent. Absent students will receive a "D" until the assignments is turned in (next block)

Homework Details:

Homework will be given twice a week.

How I use CANVAS: All classwork and homework materials are found on Canvas. This is especially useful for students who need to complete make up work. Students access our Canvas class page daily in class. Laptops (AND CHARGERS) are a required material!

How I use FOCUS:

Grades and any notes related to grades are found on Focus (NOT CANVAS). Please review notes when they are included. Grades highlighted in bold indicate demerits.

Make-Up/Missing Work Policy: Late work is allowed. However, you lose one letter grade for each class work is late (down to 50 %). Even having a partial grade is much better than a zero! While you can always at least partially make up grades during the quarter, **demerits do not go away.**

The dates for assignments on both Canvas and Focus are cross-referenced. That means if you're missing an assignment that is impacting your grade on Focus, match that date with Canvas to find the assignment.

Homework Details:

Homework is assigned once a week on Canvas, usually on Thursdays or Fridays (depending on the rolling block schedule). Students generally have approximately a week to complete homework (again depending on rolling block schedule).

Tests/Quizzes:

Final assessments are usually based on projects, rather than tests or quizzes.

Organization

Make sure you bring your required materials (including planner) every day. Always keep track of assignments through Canvas and grades through Focus. Listen actively in class and follow directions the first time!

Absences

The most important thing for them to do is try. I can give them credit for trying but I cannot give credit for work not done. Mistakes are OK and encouraged!

Finally, students can attend free tutoring for extra help!

How I use CANVAS:

EVERYTHING that we do in class is available on Canvas- daily agendas, assignments, notes, etc...

How I use FOCUS:
