Scholarship: One male and one female scholar athlete will receive a \$1,000 scholarship.

Criteria: The applicant must be a senior at OFHS, have a minimum, weighted GPA of 3.5, and have earned at least one varsity letter in his/her junior or senior year.

 2. You must have a guidance counselor or clerk verify your GPA and class rank. (Signature required below).
 3. You must get a letter of recommendation from one coach. The coach must provide examples of how you have positively impacted the lives of your fellow students. (Provide 5 copies total).
 4. The application must be completely finished when submitted or it will not be considered.
