If your child rides a bus to school each day, you can keep updated on any issues by signing up for Bus Bulletin. Bus Bulletin will notify you by text, phone call or email if:


A bus is late.


A route has changed.

Henna Hand Designs

Students were introduced to Henna hand designs and tribal markings. In many cultures, women have henna decorations applied to their hands and feet for festivals and celebrations. Before a wedding, a bride will have elaborate henna designs drawn onto her hands, arms and sometimes feet. In some regions, the groom will be decorated as well.





Fall Leaves Printmaking

The background was a lesson in glue resist and watercolor techniques using salt and alcohol. Then the students drew the outlines of leaves and veins onto Styrofoam plates and used marker to color the leaves and then made the prints on white paper.
