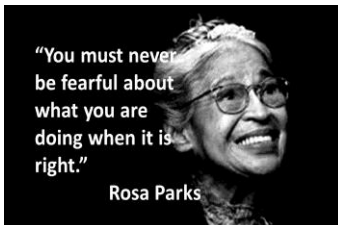

Parents.... It's Testing Time!

Schools test children to improve educational programs, to assess how well children are doing in school, and to report to the public on a school's academic progress. Parents can help their children during this time in many ways.

When your child is taking a test, you can help by making sure your child:

- *Gets plenty of rest the night before the test
- *Has a good breakfast the morning of the test
- *Arrives to school on time the morning of the test



You can support your child's learning by:

- *Be Interested – Ask your child about their school day
 - *Ask to see your child's schoolwork
 - *Attend Parent/Teacher Conferences
- *Encourage your child to bring home books from the library
 - *Take your child to the public library
 - *Ask your child to read aloud to you
- *Make sure your child completes his or her homework
- *Communicate with your child's teacher regarding homework
- *Plan a time and place for your child to study (not in front of the television)
