Parents of elementary students are asked to meet with their child's teacher to discuss and sign the compact.

Title I schools are required to develop a Parent and Family Engagement Plan. Parents are asked to provide input on this plan; parent involvement is crucial for its development. Our 2020-2021 Parent and Family Engagement Plan has been approved and parents may view it on our website or at the Title I Parent Involvement Station located in the school's front office.

Parents of students in Title I schools are entitled to information on their child's achievement level which is determined on assessments such as EOC, MAP, and the Florida Standards Assessment. Information will also be provided to parents regarding the qualification of teachers; parents are to be informed if their children are being taught by a non-highly qualified teacher for four or more consecutive weeks.

Pinellas County Schools has partnered with Sandy Hook Promise to offer the Say Something Anonymous Reporting System. Say Something allows you to submit secure & anonymous safety concerns to help identify and intervene upon at-risk individuals BEFORE they hurt themselves or others. Tips made to the Say Something Anonymous Reporting System are passed along to the appropriate law enforcement agencies and school officials.

Additionally, the district utilizes FortifyFL, a school-related suspicious activity reporting tool that allows Florida students and the community the ability to instantly relay information anonymously concerning unsafe, potentially harmful, dangerous, violent or criminal activities, or the threat of these activities, to the appropriate law enforcement agencies and school officials. FortifyFL was created and funded the by 2018 Florida Legislature as part of the Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School Public Safety Act.

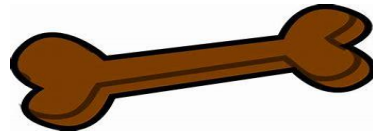

WHAT MEAL OPTIONS ARE AVAILABLE FOR PINELLAS COUNTY CHILDREN?

Starting **Thursday, October 29**, children in Pinellas County, 18 years & younger are eligible for:

- \* 7 days' worth of breakfast, lunch, snack, and dinner meals, FREE
- \* Distribution on Thursdays at 30 school locations
- \* Child does not need to be enrolled in Pinellas County Schools or be present for pickup
- \* No ID required for pickup
- \* Meals are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis
