- Students are rung on POS Computer
- Names are needed for all students

Information Needed

- Start AND end date for meal service
 - Meals Requested AND start and end times for each meal
 - Field Trip to go meals
- ***USDA will not approve payment for ANY meals served outside the meal times or meal service dates. 48 hrs minimum is needed for any changes (times/dates/to go meals)
- ***USDA will close a Break Spot school that refuses walk-ins. Violations can lead to termination of Break Spot for the District
