This session will provide parents of our freshmen and sophomore (9th and 10th grade) students information about Pinellas' Pathways to Graduation and how those pathways support students to meet Florida's requirements for graduation, and also help fulfill their goals and aspirations for school and life after high school. Parents will learn how each of Pinellas' Pathways to Graduation ensures that students meet the state's requirements which include:

- the number of credits students need to earn overall for a standard diploma under two options: standard time (4 years) and accelerated time (3 or fewer years)
- the specific courses students must pass to graduate under both time options
- the GPA that is required for graduation under both time options
- And, finally the State of Florida's FSA ELA and ALG EOC testing requirements for graduation under both time options

Lastly, this session will also share important information about the district's PSAT, ACT, and SAT inschool testing programs and explain how those exams will assist students who struggle to pass the assessments required for graduation during the 9th and 10th grades.
