Programs offered at St. Petersburg High school provide the basic district curricula enhanced with special teaching techniques and thematic lessons. JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT 3DE PROGRAM

3DE is a joint venture between PCS, Junior Achievement and the business community. The program brings real-world connectivity into the everyday academic experience to increase student engagement, strengthen comprehension, build critical thinking and accelerate academic performance. Students in the program will have opportunities to explore a wide variety of careers, participate in internships and interact with business professionals, so that by the time they graduate they will have the knowledge, skills and confidence they need to be prepared for college, career and life.



AIR FORCE JROTC

This program will begin in the 2023-2024 school year. In Air Force ROTC, students learn the principles of leadership in the classroom and apply these principles into practice outside of the classroom through hands-on management experience and valuable leadership-building exercises. Courses focus on the importance of effective leadership, application of leadership concepts and the role of a military leader in today's society.



CENTER FOR CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGIES

The Center for Construction Technologies is a program that gives students in grades nine through twelve the opportunity to learn a construction trade while in high school. The program is designed for students to earn both a high school diploma and industry recognized National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) certifications at the same time. By the time students graduate, they will be at a more advanced stage to enter postsecondary education, apprenticeship training or enter the workplace at a higher wage
