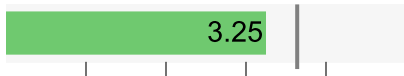

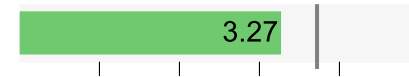

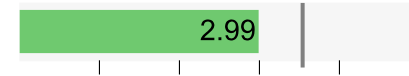

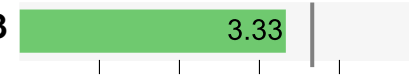

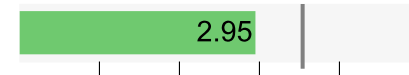

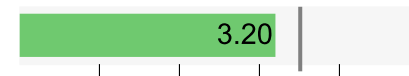

E2: My school provides me with challenging curriculum and learning experiences.

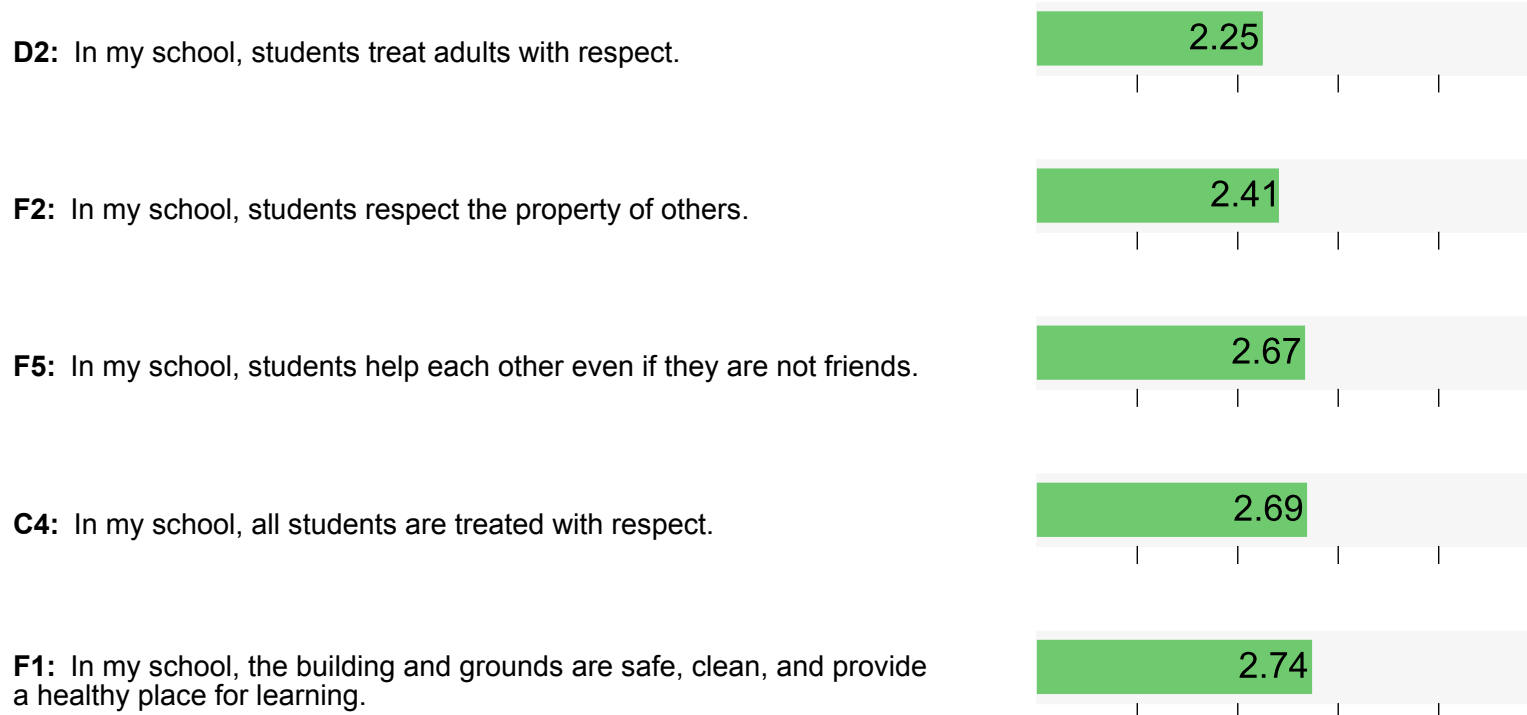


E10: All of my teachers explain their expectations for learning and behavior so I can be successful.

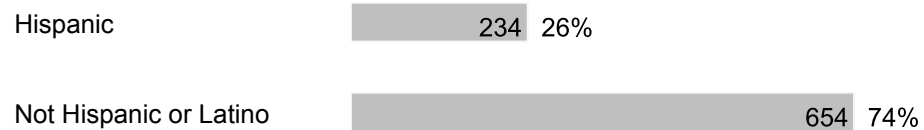

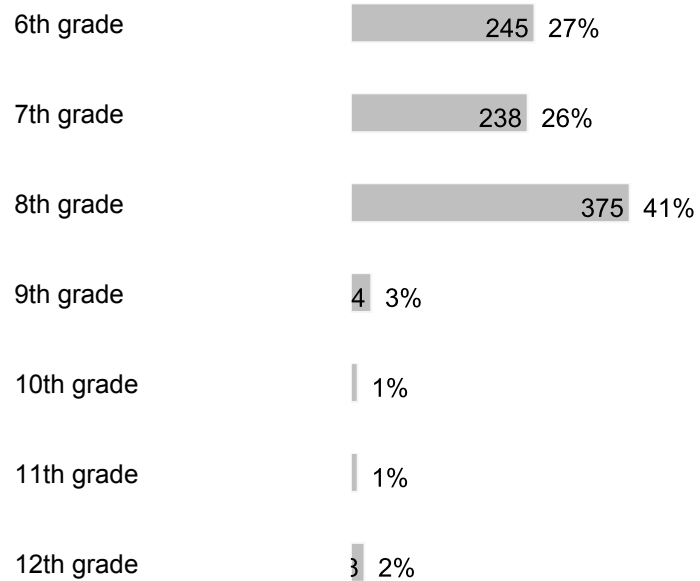
